



## Dr. Leonardo Leiderman

Professor of Economics at the Eitan Berglas School of Economics &  
Chief Economic Advisor at Bank Hapoalim, Tel Aviv

Leonardo Leiderman is the Jack and Lisa Yael Professor of Economics at the Eitan Berglas School of Economics, Tel-Aviv University and the Chief Economic Advisor of Bank Hapoalim. Professor Leiderman is also head of the Pinhas Sapir Center for Development at Tel-Aviv University.

Among previous positions held by Professor Leiderman, for two-and-a-half years up to October 2002 he served as Managing Director and Head of Emerging Market Economics at Deutsche Bank in New York and London. Prior to that, from 1996 to 2000 he was Senior Director and Head of the Research Department at the Bank of Israel. From 1988 to 1991 he was chairman of the Economics Department, and from 1994 to 1996 he headed the Pinhas Sapir Center for Development at Tel-Aviv University.

Leiderman (who was born in Argentina and is a citizen of Israel) joined Tel-Aviv University in January 1979, after completing his Ph.D. at the University of Chicago under the supervision of Nobel Laureate Professor Robert E. Lucas, Jr.

Over the years, Leiderman held visiting positions at various entities especially in the US, such as the University of Chicago, Boston University, the International Monetary Fund, the World Bank, and the Inter-American Development Bank. Professor Leiderman has also consulted for various central banks and ministries of finance, including those of Brazil, Colombia, Mexico, Peru, Hungary, Czech Republic, Venezuela and Turkey.

Leonardo Leiderman's published work includes more than 70 articles in professional journals and books, and 7 written or edited books. His research has covered an ample list of topics within the areas of macroeconomic policy, monetary theory, and international finance. Most of his recent work deals with central bank policy, inflation targeting, and capital inflows to emerging markets.
